D1	 <p>Board the coach at settled place and time. The first scenery is Dr. Sun Yat-sen's Mausoleum. Dr. Sun Yatsen's Mausoleum sits on the southern slope of the Purple Mountain in the eastern suburbs of the city. Dr. Sun Yatsen is a great man because he devoted 40 years of his life to pursuing his dream to overthrow the feudal monarchy and build an untied democratic China. The mausoleum site was first recommended to Dr. Sun Yatsen by the abbot of Linggu Temple for its good geomantic omen. One day in April, 1912 when he went hunting to the site with his friends, Dr. Sun Yatsen was really so amazed by the beautiful environment that he wished the people would allow him to be buried there after his death. He expressed this desire again in his sickbed in 1925. Dr. Sun Yatsen's Mausoleum is designed in the shape of a liberty bell, intending to remind people never to get self-contented.</p> <p>Then, we will go to Linggu Temple, which is 1.5km east to Dr Sun Yat-sen's Mausoleum. Linggu Temple lies about one and a half kilometers to the east of Dr. Sun Yatsen's Mausoleum. It was called Jiangshan Temple in the ancient times and its original site was in Dulongfu at the foot of the Purple Mountain. However, in the early</p>	Lunch Supper	无

days of the Ming Dynasty (1368-1644), Emperor Zhu Yuanzhang chose that place to build his tomb, thus the temple had to be moved and rebuilt at the present site and was renamed as the Linggu Temple with an inscription "The First Buddhist Forest " at the entrance to the mountain. Inside the entrance there is a secluded footpath with thousands of pine trees, verdant and luxuriant, so it is called the "Valley of Spirit Deep in Pines". It is one of the 48 attractions in Nanjing.

After the temple, we will go to Ming Tomb. The 600-year-old Ming Tomb, lying at the southern foot of the Purple Mountain, is the tomb for Zhu Yuanzhang, the first emperor of the Ming Dynasty from 1368 to 1398. It is approved by UNSECO as one of the World Cultural Heritage in 2003.

Our last visit will be Nanjing Museum. Nanjing museum, first built in 1933 as the National Central Museum, is situated at the southern side of the Purple Mountain, with trees and flowers around. In 1950, it was renamed National Nanjing Museum. It covers an area of 10000 square meters, and has a rich collection of cultural relics, among which many are national treasures. The museum was designed by Xu Jinzhi, Li Huibai, Liang Sicheng and Liu Dunzhen. As we all know, the Tang Dynasty architecture is a typical representative of Chinese ancient architecture. Nevertheless, Tang buildings were rarely discovered then. But some Liao Dynasty (10th—12th) buildings had been discovered and studied by the Chinese architects. The museum, with yellow glazed tiles, is a copy of Liao Dynasty palace. With solid structure and gentle curves, the museum looks magnificent and elegant. Among the 419000 items, there are jade, porcelain, pottery, silk embroidery, bronze, wood carvings, bamboo carvings, gold and silver wares, paintings, calligraphy, and farming tools. The visit to Nanjing Museum should be booked one day before the visit.
